Day 1 — Arrival in Johannesburg

Arrive at OR Tambo International Airport, where you are welcomed and transferred to your hotel in the upscale Rosebank/Sandton area. The remainder of the day is intentionally unstructured, allowing time to unwind after international travel. Guests may relax at the hotel, enjoy nearby cafés, or explore the neighborhood at their own pace. The evening is open for a casual dinner and rest before the journey begins in earnest.

Day 2 — Soweto, History, and Freedom Stories

Today is devoted to understanding South Africa's social and political journey. The morning begins in **Soweto**, one of the most historically significant townships in the country. Highlights include the **Hector Pieterson Memorial & Museum**, where the youth uprising of 1976 is powerfully documented, and an inspirational conversation with Antoinette Sithole.

The experience continues at the **Apartheid Museum**, offering a deeply moving, immersive look at South Africa's past and the triumph of democracy. The afternoon provides a lighter contrast with time at the Rosebank African Craft Market and nearby shopping areas. Evening returns to the hotel for relaxation and reflection.

Day 3 — Into the Wild: Johannesburg to Sabi Sands

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for a flight to Skukuza, the gateway to South Africa's premier safari region. A short road journey brings you into the heart of the **Sabi Sands Game Reserve**, where luxury lodge accommodations await.

Following afternoon high tea, set out on your first open-vehicle game drive. As the sun sets, experience your first close encounters with African wildlife in their natural habitat. Dinner is served at the lodge, often beneath the stars, surrounded by the sounds of the bush.

Day 4 — Safari Immersion

This full day is dedicated to the rhythm of safari life. Early-morning and late-afternoon game drives provide opportunities to spot the Big Five and countless other species, guided by expert rangers. Between drives, enjoy leisure time at the lodge—whether relaxing by the pool, journaling, or simply taking in the landscape. The day balances adventure with restoration.

Day 5 — Safari to the Cape Winelands

Begin the morning with a final safari drive followed by breakfast. From Skukuza, travel onward to the Western Cape and the picturesque town of **Stellenbosch**. Nestled among rolling vineyards and historic architecture, your wine-estate hotel offers a serene contrast to the bush.

The afternoon is free to settle in and enjoy the surroundings. In the evening, savor a curated wine tasting and dinner, highlighting the region's world-class culinary and viticulture traditions.

Day 6 — Wine, Gardens, and Heritage

Today explores the beauty and craftsmanship of the Cape Winelands. The morning features a visit to **Babylonstoren Wine Estate**, known for its lush gardens, cellar tours, and refined tastings, followed by lunch.

The afternoon continues with an additional wine experience in the **Franschhoek Valley**, celebrated for its French Huguenot roots and exceptional estates. Evening is unhurried, allowing guests to enjoy dinner at leisure in the winelands.

Day 7 — Cape Peninsula Discovery

A full-day guided journey showcases some of South Africa's most iconic coastal scenery. Travel along **Chapman's Peak Drive**, weather permitting, before exploring the dramatic cliffs of **Cape Point Nature Reserve**.

At **Boulders Beach**, observe the charming African penguin colony up close. After lunch at a seaside restaurant, return toward Stellenbosch with time to explore the town's shops and galleries. Dinner is enjoyed locally before heading back to the hotel.

Day 8 — Winelands to Cape Town

Depart the countryside for **Cape Town**, beginning with a half-day city orientation. Highlights include the colorful **Bo-Kaap**, a walk through the Company's Garden, and a visit to the Desmond and Lea Tutu Legacy Foundation.

Weather permitting, ascend **Table Mountain** by cable car for sweeping city and ocean views. The afternoon concludes with hotel check-in at the V&A Waterfront area, followed by an evening at leisure.

Day 9 — Robben Island & Farewell Celebration

This morning features a ferry excursion to **Robben Island**, where guided tours recount the imprisonment of Nelson Mandela and other freedom leaders. The experience is sobering, powerful, and essential to understanding modern South Africa.

The afternoon is free for shopping and exploration along the V&A Waterfront. In the evening, gather for a festive farewell dinner featuring African cuisine, live drumming, and cultural performance—an uplifting close to the journey.

Day 10 — Departure

After breakfast, transfer to Cape Town International Airport for your onward journey home, carrying memories of history, culture, wildlife, and connection.
